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COMMUNITY DATA

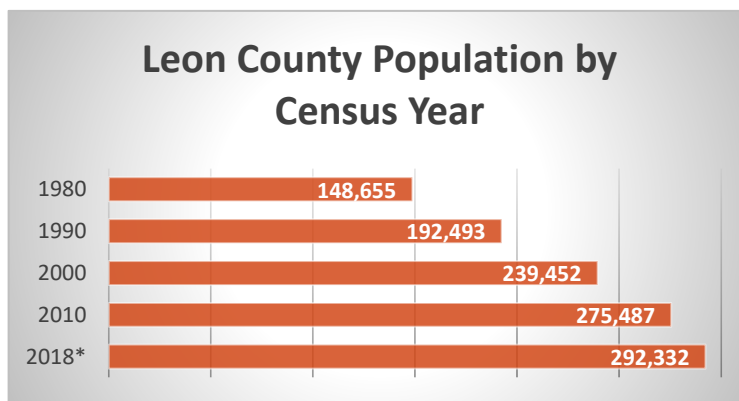
With its distinctive boot shape, Leon County is the 22nd most populous county in Florida based on the 2018 population estimates (292,332) provided by the Florida Legislature's Office of Economic and Demographic Research (EDR). Leon County is the 37th largest county based on land area which results in the county being the 17th most dense of the 67 counties in Florida with 438.6 people per square land mile. It borders the Georgia State line to the north and is surrounded by four counties (Gadsden, Jefferson, Liberty, & Wakulla), the most populous of which is Gadsden County with an estimated 45,894



residents. There are two census recognized cities in Leon County (Tallahassee and Woodville) and several unincorporated communities. The county seat is Tallahassee which is also home to the State's capital. Within the county are 68 census tracts ranging in area from half a square mile to 142 square miles and populations varying from about one thousand to 10,000 residents.

The data for this section will be presented at the countywide and zip code level. Where available and appropriate, data will also be presented for selected census tracts that have noteworthy characteristics. Data for each of the 68 census tracts is provided at the end of this document.

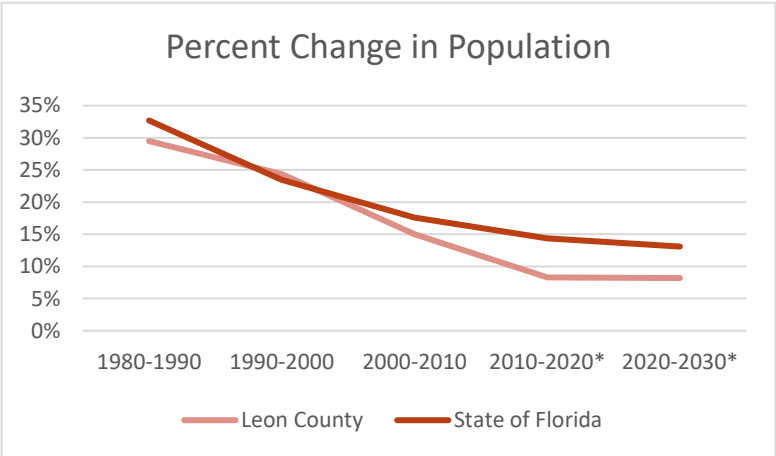
Population



Leon County's population has almost doubled since 1980. From the 2010 census until the 2018 estimate, there has been a 6% increase in the county's population compared with 11% statewide.

The trend in population change for county has mirrored the State in terms of the declining percent increase, although both the State and county do continue to show increase. Projections from EDR suggest that Leon County will gain close to 30,000 residents from the 2018 estimates to 2030 census. EDR data is used for this statewide and countywide perspective but is not available at the code and census tract-levels for many of the attributes that are discussed in this report. As a result, the Census Bureau, American Community Survey (ACS) data will be the primary source of population data. The ACS data is available at the county, zip code and census-tract levels.



The ACS 2017 data and the 2000 census data show that Leon County has had a 19.39% increase in population from 2000 to 2017 while the population Statewide has increased 26.88%.

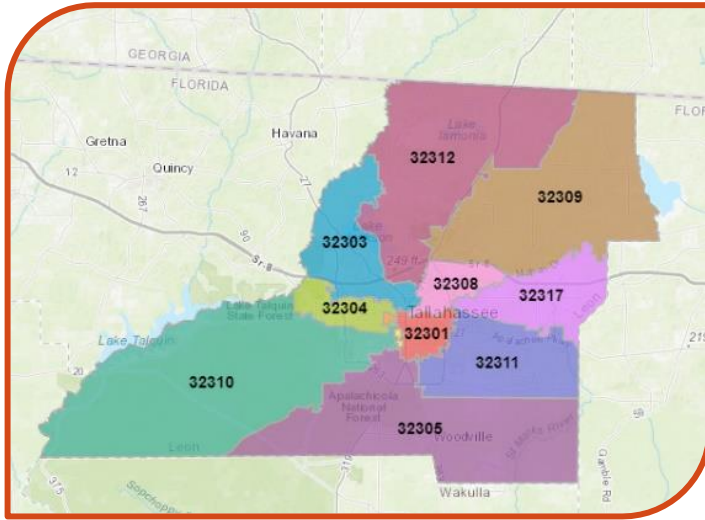

Zip Codes

Leon County has ten zip codes designated as *General*, indicating areas where people reside. The other zip codes are designated as either *P.O. Box* or *Unique*. Two of the Unique zip codes are solely used for the universities (32306 for Florida State University and 32307 for Florida A&M University) for mailing purposes and have no demographic data. The distribution of Leon County's population among these 10 zip codes areas where people reside is provided below.



As shown

in the table to the right, the most populous zip codes are 32303 and 32304 each representing about a sixth of the county's population, with zip code 32304 being the densest (population per square mile), followed closely by zip code 32301.

Census Tracts

Census tracts are small, relatively permanent statistical subdivisions of a county. They are uniquely numbered in each county with a numeric code. Census tracts average about 4,000 inhabitants with a minimum population of 1,200 and a maximum population of 8,000. Census tracts are designed to be relatively permanent over time. Any changes are documented so data can be compared from decade to decade. Census tracts with more than 8,000 people are split into 2 or more tracts and are given an extension to their existing numeric code. Census tracts with less than 1,200 people are merged with a neighboring tract and are given a new numeric code. (Census.gov)

Leon County has 68 census tracts. The table below displays the 68 Leon County Census Tracts along with a geographic description of its location.

Notes about Total Population:

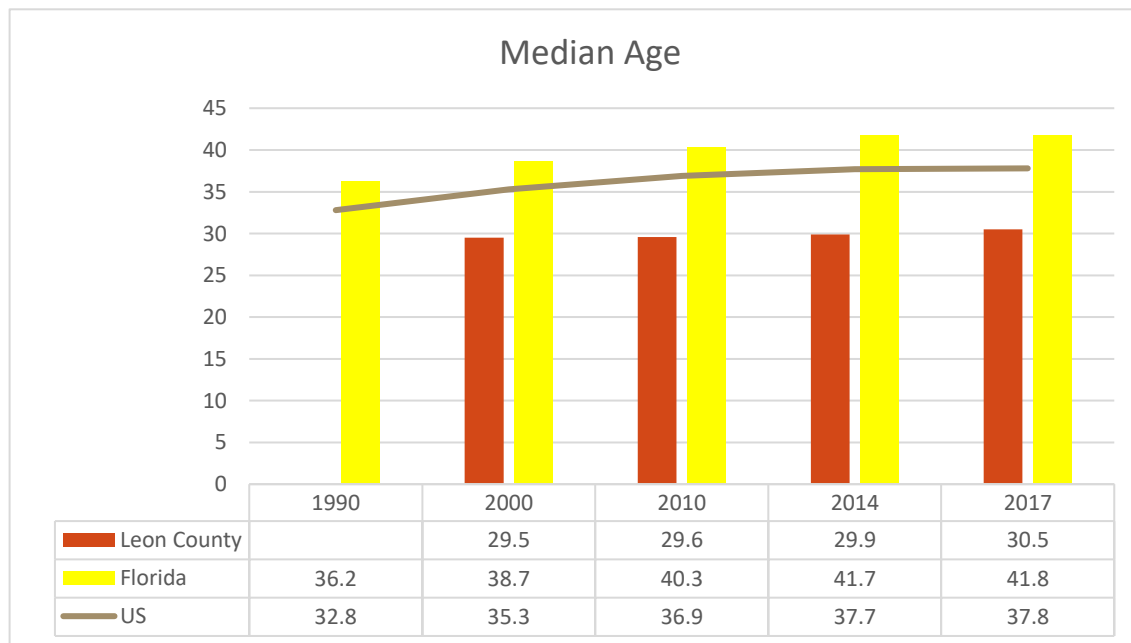
- Leon County's population is projected to continue to increase over the next ten years.
- Zip codes 32303 and 32304 are the two most populous areas in Leon County each accounting for approximately one-sixth (17%) of Leon County's total population.
- Zip codes 32301, 32309, 32312 each have about one-tenth (10-11%) of the county's population.
- The densest zip codes are 32304, 32301, 32308 & 32303 and each have well over 1,000 people per square mile with 32304 and 32301 at approximately 3,000 people per square mile. The remaining zip codes have densities below 500 people per square mile.
- Many of the least populated census tracts are showing a decline in population from 2014 to 2017.

- The following four tracts have 2017 estimated population above 8,000 which is the maximum population size based on the Census Bureau's definition of a census tract and will likely need to be split.
- 25.08 – NE/Georgia Line
 - 24.12 – Killearn Lakes Golden Eagle
 - 9.01 – Miccosukee Hills
 - 21.04 – Gretchen Everhart

Demographics

Age

Leon County's median age has been 10 years lower than the State of Florida's median age for several years. This is not surprising with the two State University System (SUS) residential schools (Florida Agriculture and Mechanical University and Florida State University) located in Leon County. This phenomenon is also seen in Alachua County which has a small total population (259,865, 2017 ACS 5-year estimate) like Leon County but is home to a major state university (University of Florida). Florida is also home to many retirees and retirement communities and thus the median age for Florida is higher than the U.S. and Leon County's median age.

Race and Ethnicity

Leon County's racial/ethnic mix differs significantly from the State among Black and Hispanic populations. As shown below, close to 25% of the 2017 population in the State is Hispanic (includes any race) while Hispanics make up only 6% of the population in Leon County. The opposite phenomenon is seen with the Black population (non-Hispanic). While only 15% of the State's population is Black, Leon County's population is comprised of 31% Black.

Notes about Demographics:

- Leon County is the youngest county in Florida followed by Alachua based on Median Age (2013-2017 ACS). The median age in Leon County is 30.5 and 31.2 in Alachua County. The median age in Florida is 41.8.
- Zip Code 32304 has the lowest median age at 21.8 years. The second lowest median age is 27.8 in Zip Code 32301.
- Four of the ten zip codes have a median age greater than 40 years. Those zip codes and their median ages are: 32309 (43.2), 32317 (42.9), 32312 (42.7) and 32308 (41.4).
- Across the State, 8.7% of the population is 18-24 years old compared with 22.6% for Leon County. In Zip Code 32304, 63.1% of the population is 18-24 years old.
- Over half of the population is female in the State (51.1%) and in Leon County (52.4%).
